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CHANGES IN EXHIBITION SCHEDULE OF MUSEUM OF MODERN ART

The exhibition of STAGE DESIGNS FOR THE BALLET SOCIETY, 1947-48, which the Museum of Modern Art, 11 West 53 Street, originally scheduled for January 7, will open to the public Wednesday, January 21, to be on view through April 18.

MASTERPIECES OF LOUIS SULLIVAN, originally scheduled to open March 3, has been postponed to May 26. In its place, opening March 3, will be an exhibition of WEDGELOCK HANDLES DESIGNED BY THOMAS LAMB, which will demonstrate a process of scientific research in the anatomy of the human hand, leading up to a patent of the widest applicability. This handle has an exceptional shape and has already been adapted with great success to a wide variety of objects.
