The scope of the Exhibition extends from the building of the Vatican Suseum in Home in 1770 to the original Hedsworth Atheneum, erected at Hartford in 1842. It will include prints, plans and descriptions, as well as a catalog of the Exhibition. It has been assembled by Professor H. R. Hitchcock, Jr., head of the Art Department of Wesleyan University.

The Exhibiton of Exam Early Husen Architecture has been shown at the Atheneum in Hartford and at Yele University. It will eccpy the larger part of the fourth floor of The Huseum of Hedern Art and will run concurrently with the Exhibition of Hachine Art now on view, both exhibitions closing April 30.
