BURR TILLSTROM, GILBERT SELDES TO DISCUSS TELEVISION AND ART EDUCATION

Television in art education will be emphasized during the 11th Annual Conference of the Committee on Art Education to be held at the Museum of Modern Art, 11 West 53 Street, from March 19 through March 22. This national organization sponsored by the Museum of Modern Art consists of 1,200 art educators from all parts of the country.

A special performance of Burr Tillstrom's "Kukla, Fran and Ollie" will be given on Thursday, March 19, at 8 p.m. for the Committee members. Mr. Tillstrom will give an informal talk preceding the performance.

Other sessions will cover presentation and analysis of recent TV programs, an informal talk by Gilbert Seldes and a group discussion on "How Can Wo Implement Better Educational Programming?" A detailed program of the sessions on TV is enclosed.
