SPRING TERM AT MUSEUM OF MODERN ART'S PEOPLE'S ART CENTER

Among the 38 different art classes being offered for the spring term at the Museum of Modern Art's People's Art Center, 21 West 53 Street, are several designed for beginning adults who have never before worked in any creative medium and a discussion and criticism course for advanced students who work independently but who would like to have the benefit of expert criticism as well as an understanding of the development of modern painting. Classes for children and young people, aged 3 to 18 years old, and classes for parents and their children, aged 3 to 5 years old, will also be offered during the spring term which begins January 24 and runs through May 23.

As classes are limited in size, applicants are urged to complete registration and payment of fees as early as possible before the beginning of the spring term.

Adult classes meet once a week and are held both in the evening and during the day. As in past years, the Center will offer courses for adult amateurs in beginning, intermediate and advanced painting, drawing and sculpture, as well as life classes, ceramic and wood sculpture workshops and classes in woodworking and jewelry making. "Old Masters to Moderns," a course of guided visits to outstanding art galleries, museums and private collections in New York will also be offered to adult students.

Children's and young people's classes meet once a week and are all organized by age group and no emphasis is placed on special talents or previous training.
