MUSEUM OF MODERN ART ANNOUNCES SIX EXHIBITIONS

The Museum of Modern Art today announced six major exhibitions as part of the summer fall and winter schedule for 1958 - 59. The first is a large selection of objects from the Museum Design Collection which will open in June and remain on view throughout the summer.

Early in the fall of 1958 painted wood reliefs, sculptures and paintings by the Swiss artist Jean Arp will be shown in the first major retrospective of his work in America. This will be followed by an exhibition of paintings by the Spanish artist Joan Miró. The last Museum of Modern Art exhibition devoted to his work was held in 1941.

During the winter season of 1958-59 an exhibition of Recent Acquisitions to the Museum Collections will be followed by a one-man show of paintings by the American artist Willem de Kooning. In the spring the Junior Council of the Museum will sponsor the showing of Recent Sculpture USA.
