FILMS OF DIRECTOR FRED ZINNEMANN CONTINUE AT MUSEUM OF MODERN ART

The final programs in the series "The Films of Fred Zinnemann" at the Museum of Modern Art, 11 West 53 Street, are, March 28, From Here to Eternity (1953), with Burt Lancaster, Montgomery Clift, Deborah Kerr and Frank Sinatra; March 29, A Hatful of Rain (1957), with Anthony Franciosa, Don Murray, Eva Marie Saint and Lloyd Nolan; March 30 - April 2, The Story of Dr. Carver (1938), a Pete Smith Specialty, and The Search (1948), with Montgomery Clift and Aline MacMahon. There will be daily showings at 3 and 5:30 p.m.

A new film series of recent Museum acquisitions will begin April 3 - 5 with Seventh Heaven (1927), directed by Frank Borzage, with Janet Gaynor and Charles Farrell; daily at 3 p.m. only.

Admission to the Museum, 75 cents for adults and 25 cents for children under 16, includes a film ticket.
