FILM EDUCATORS CONFERENCE AT MUSEUM OF MODERN ART

The third Conference on Motion Picture Education will be held today and tomorrow (March 25 and 26) at the Museum of Modern Art, 11 West 53 Street. Organized by the Museum's Film Library, the annual event will be attended by film educators from universities throughout the country.

A varied program will include a talk by Dore Schary, producer, director and writer, on "New Freedom of the Screen - Its Use and Abuse;" a roundtable discussion, "Minimum Requirements for B.A. in Cinema," led by Professor Hugh Gray of the University of California's Department of Cinema; and screenings of films prepared by the Museum at the suggestion of last year's conference.

Robert Gessner, first Professor of Motion Pictures at New York University, will report on progress toward establishing an association of film professors. "In view of the enormous expansion of film and TV curricula," says Miss Margareta Akermark, Circulation Director of the Film Library, "we hope that definite action toward forming such an association will be taken at this third conference."
