Edward Steichen, dean of photographers, received a gift from the Photographic Society of Germany, at a dinner celebrating his 82nd birthday last night (March 27) at the Musueum Modern Art. Fritz Gruber, President of the Society, presented the gift, a portfolio of fetures by the famous German photographer, Albert Renger-Patzsch, whose work Mr. Steichen as long admired.

At the same time Henry Allen Moe, Vice-Chairman of the Museum's Board of Trustees, mounced that the Photography Center in the new wing, scheduled for completion in 1964, ill be named in Steichen's honor. Mr. Steichen has been Director of the Museum's epartment of Photography since 1947.

The dinner preceded a preview of 300 photographs taken by Steichen over the last 65 ars. The exhibition opened to the public today, (March 28).
