You are cordially invited to come or send a representative to a press view at the Museum of Modern Art from 11 am to 4 pm on Tuesday, April 19, of Fifty Modern Paintings and Sculpture which will be sold at public auction at the Parke-Bernet Galleries on April 27.

The paintings and sculptures, which have been especially donated for the Benefit of the Museum's 30th Anniversary Fund, will be on public exhibition at Parke-Bernet from Saturday, April 23 through April 26. They will not be on public view at the Museum but are being installed in a temporary exhibition for the press view and for a private reception which will be held Wednesday evening.

Release date for reviews of the works in the sale is Saturday, April 23, the day the exhibition opens at Parke-Bernet.

The sale, which is expected to gross about three-quarters of a million dollars, will be the first art auction carried on a closed-circuit television network. Buyers in Chicago, Los Angeles and Dallas will participate in the bidding along with the audience in the salesrooms at Parke-Bernet in New York.
