NORMALK SEMIOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS VISIT MUSEUM OF MODERN ART:

pirty-eight students from the Norwalk Senior High School, accompanied by two teachers, kr. James M. Prevotali and Mr. Charles T. White, and Mrs. William H. Hetzel, a parent, visited the Museum of Modern Art in New York today (Wednesday, June 9) as part of a program to broaden their interests and cultural background.

Among the exhibitions they saw were paintings and sculptures from the Museum's Collection, arranged chronologically to give a history of modern European and American art from 1875 to the present, a selection of chairs, china and household objects from the Design Collection, also covering about the same period, and a sampling from the Print and Photography Collections.

The major lean exhibition on view which they visited was "Art Nouveau", the art of the'90s and the turn of the century, up to 1905, including several hundred paintings, sculptures, prints, posters, books, design objects and furniture from fourteen countries in this primarily decorative style.

They saw an exhibition of "Portraits from the Huseum Collections", one hundred paintings, sculptures, drawings, prints, posters and photographs devoted to self-portraits, portraits of writers, portraits of dealers, portraits from the pages of history, as well as from today's newspapers.

They examined a 13'7" x 6' x 5'2" high model of the additional wing the Museum plans to build at the conclusion of its 30th Anniversary Fund Drive and walked through the Sculpture Garden and saw an outdoor show, three structures by Buckminster Fuller: a radome and two experimental projects. Inside the dome is an exhibition of "Art Education for Every Child".
