The Children's Art Carnival is being presented under the auspices of Mrs. John F. Kennedy to the National Children's Museum of India by The Asia Society and by The International Council of The Museum of Modern Art, New York, of which Mrs. Kennedy is an Honorary Member. It is intended not only to give pleasure to the children of India but to function as a teaching device and serve as a training center for art teachers in the educational program of the National Children's Museum recently established in New Delhi under the leadership of Mrs. Indira Gandhi.

Mrs. Kennedy will give Mrs. Gandhi in the name of The International Council and The Asia Society an illustrated presentation portfolio which describes the Carnival's purpose and program. The Carnival itself is expected to open in India in 1963.
