John L. Loeb has been elected a trustee of the Museum of Modern Art, William A. M. Burden, Chairman of the Board, announced today. Mr. Loeb is senior partner of Carl M. Loeb, Rhoades and Company. A graduate of Harvard College, Mr. Loeb has been in the banking business in New York since 1931 and is a director of several corporations. From 1942 to 1944 he served with the Treasury Department and the Office of War Mobilization in Washington. He is also a member of the Board of Governors of New York Hospital, a trustee of Montefiore Hospital and a director of Beekman Downtown Hospital.

Mr. Burden also announced that Willard C. Butcher has been elected Treasurer of the Museum. Mr. Butcher is a Senior Vice President of the Chase Manhattan Bank and a director of the Union Labor Life Insurance Company. He was born in Bronxville, New York and now lives in Wilton, Connecticut.
