JIMMY MC GRIFF AND JAM FACTORY

PERFORM IN FINAL JAZZ IN GARDEN CONCERT

Jimmy Mc Griff and his Organ Trio and New York rock group Jam Factory will perform in the final concert of the Jazz in the Garden series at The Museum of Modern Art on Thursday, August 27, from 7:30 to 9:30 p.m. in the Museum's Sculpture Garden.

Mc Griff, from Philadelphia, burst on the jazz scene in 1962 as a "jazz organ wizard." He and his Organ Trio -- consisting of Thornel Schwartz on guitar, Arthur Theus on saxophone, and Jimmy Smith on drums -- have played numerous jazz festivals, and recorded the hit "I've Got a Woman" as well as numerous albums.

Jam Factory -- Mark Hoffman, Gene Mc Cormack, Steve Marcone, Joe English, Kent De Felice, and Earl Ford -- all live in upstate New York, and combine jazz, country, rock, pop, and classical music. Jam Factory records for Epic Records.

The Jazz in the Garden series is headed by Program Director Ed Bland. The sound in the Garden is by Jack Weisberg Associates. Admission is \$1.00 in addition to the regular Museum entrance fee (\$1.75, members free). Tickets go on sale the Saturday before the concert, and are available until concert time. The Garden Restaurant is open for refreshments, and the Museum galleries are open until 10:00 during the summer. In case of rain, concert is cancelled.
