Lives in New York.

GOLDTHWAITE, Anne: Born Montgomery, Alabama. Lives in  
New York.

HARKAVY, Minna: American, born Esthonia, 1895. Lives  
in New York.

KUNIYOSHI, Yasuo: American, born Japan, 1893. Studied  
in Los Angeles and under K. H. Miller and Henri in  
New York. Lives in New York.

MacIVER, Loren: Born New York, 1909. Lives in  
New York.

NAKIAN, Reuben: Born College Point, N. Y., 1897. Studied  
with Homer Boss, Manship, Lachaise. Lives in New York.
