SINGER/SONGWRITER HARRY HALL AT SUMMERGARDEN ON SEPTEMBER 7 AND 8

Harry Hall will play acoustic guitar and sing a program of his own songs on Friday and Saturday, September 7 and 8, at 8 pm in the Sculpture Garden of The Museum of Modern Art.

Born in Staten Island and raised in Louisiana, Harry Hall has played with various bands, first in Kansas and then in California. While on the West Coast he joined the Self Realization Fellowship and he feels that his music reflects the teachings of yoga. In 1971 he returned East to sign with Musicor Records. Although he is usually backed by his band, Harry Hall and Sun, for his Summer-garden performance he will perform alone.

Summergarden is Mobil Foundation's gift to New York. It enables The Museum of Modern Art to open its Abby Aldrich Rockefeller Sculpture Garden without charge on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday evenings from 6 to 11 pm, through September 30. Entertainment scheduled for Friday and Saturday nights begins at 8 pm. Access to the garden is through the gates at 8 W. 54 Street.

Next week's performers will be the Multigravitational group, aerial dancers.
