LECTURES ON D. W. GRIFFITH
AT THE MUSEUM OF MODERN ART

In conjunction with a major retrospecive of D. W. Griffith films, The Museum of Modern Art will present two illustrated lectures on Thursday evenings at 8 p.m. during the month of February.

On February 6, Ron Mottram, Assistant Professor at the State University of New York, Purchase, will discuss "Film History in the Making -- The Early Career of D. W. Griffith." The second lecture, "From Shot to Image -- On the Formal Aspects of Griffith's Biograph Work," will be given by Tom Gunning, Adjunct Lecturer at Brooklyn College, on February 20.
