

STEPHEN HARVEY IN CHARGE OF "LOOKING AT FILM" LECTURE SERIES

The Department of Film of The Museum of Modern Art has named Stephen Harvey as coordinator of the "Looking at Film" series of courses it is now offering to the general public. Prior to this appointment, Mr. Harvey worked for four years in the Museum's Film Study Center.
