FRANK T. CARY ELECTED TRUSTEE OF THE MUSEUM OF MODERN ART

Frank T. Cary, Chairman of the Board and Chief Executive Officer of International Business Machines Corporation, has been elected a Trustee of The Museum of Modern Art, William S. Paley, Chairman of the Board, announced today.

Mr. Cary joined the International Business Machines Corporation in 1948 as a marketing representative in a Data Processing Division office in Los Angeles.

He held various management positions on the West Coast and in Data Processing Division headquarters and became Division President in 1964.

Two years later he was named general manager of the Data Processing Group and was elected an IBM Vice President.
