Beginning Monday, September 14th, the Museum of Modern Art will resume its winter hours, which are: Weekdays, 10-6 and Sundays 2-6. It will continue its policy of remaining open from 8 until 10 every evening except Saturday and Sunday.

It has been arranged by the direction to extend the Memorial Exhibition of the Collection of Miss L.P. Bliss from the originally announced closing date of September 27th through Tuesday, October 6th.

Public interest in the Collection is attested by the fact that the attendance at the Bliss Memorial Exhibition was 25,262 until September 1st, as contrasted with 16,407 for a similar period during the previous summer.
