NOTE: The Museum's exhibition Britain At War, announced for November 20, has been postponed to December 4 as the pictures have not yet arrived and there is no information further than that they are on their way.

On Tuesday, November 26, in connection with Art Week the Museum of Modern Art, 11 West 53 Street, will open two exhibitions of work by American artists and designers: Color Prints Under Ten Dollars and Useful Objects Under Ten Dollars. The prints will be on sale at the Museum. Check and price list will be furnished for the exhibition of Useful Objects but they will not be sold at the Museum.

The Museum's purpose in presenting these exhibitions is to stimulate public interest in moderately priced American graphic art and well-designed articles. This is the third exhibition of Useful Objects which the Museum has held. This year the exhibition has been scheduled to open during Art Week and will be supplemented by the exhibition of prints by American artists under ten dollars. The exhibitions will close Christmas Eve.
