TWO EXHIBITIONS AT THE MUSEUM OF MODERN ART FEATURE FILMS FROM ARGENTINA

ARGENTINA: RECENT FILMS April 28 - May 25, 1989

ARGENTINA: THE '50s AND '60s May 26 - June 8, 1989

Argentina boasts one of the oldest film establishments in the world, but its history has been plagued by censorship. Two successive programs at The Museum of Modern Art examine periods in Argentine filmmaking that witnessed major political change and upheaval. ARGENTINA: RECENT FILMS, from April 28 to May 25, 1989, focuses on films made since the fall of the Junta in 1983-84. ARGENTINA: THE '50s AND '60s, from May 26 to June 8, highlights works by young directors made during and after the fall of Juan Perón in the mid-fifties.

ARGENTINA: RECENT FILMS demonstrates the reemergence of a vital national cinema in a country still recovering from the Junta's seven-year regime of terror and oppression. Twenty-three works, made between 1983 and 1988, explore a legacy of exile and alienation and display a determination to reclaim a lost culture. The exhibition includes the New York premieres of Victor Dinezon's Open from 6 to Midnight (1987) and Fernando E. Solanas's South (1988), winner of the Prize for Best Direction in Cannes.

Since the arrival of democracy in 1983, many Argentine filmmakers have been committed to making films that help further the process of democratization. Miguel Perez follows recent history in The Lost Republic (1983), which reviews political events in Argentina before the military coup. Héctor Olivera looks at repression under the former military dictatorship in

Night of the Pencils (1986), a literal reenactment of events under the Junta. Alberto Fischerman explores issues facing returning exiles in The Days of June (1985), in which a young man returns to his homeland and finds himself in political danger. Raul Tosso considers the themes of isolation and alienation in Geronima (1985), a story of a Mapuche Indian who challenges her position as a cultural outsider.

Two films in the series are devoted to the famed Isabel "Evita" Perón who, following her husband's death in 1974, ruled Argentina until she was overthrown by the military coup in 1976. Eduardo Mignona's Evita: Listen if You Want To (1984) dramatizes her life from childhood through marriage to Perón. Tulio Demichelli's documentary The Mystery of Eva Perón (1986) offers eye witness accounts and footage of the charismatic leader's public and private life.

ARGENTINA: THE '50s AND '60s presents a selection of ten rarely seen films made between 1952 and 1965. This period witnessed a new wave of talented Argentine directors rebelling against the perceived conservatism of their predecessors. Their films, which explored sexual and religious issues, were made on small budgets and were shot mainly in Buenos Aires using little-known or nonprofessional actors.

The program includes two films by Fernando Birri, who left Argentina in the forties and studied cinema in Rome during his exile. After Perón was ousted, Birri returned to Argentina and established a documentary film school. The two films, <u>Tire die</u> (1956-58) and <u>Los inundados</u> (1961), profoundly affected Latin American filmmakers by establishing a cinema dedicated to social realities. Other works in this program include Fernando Ayala's <u>The Boss</u> (1958), Leonard Favio's <u>Chronicle of a Boy Alone</u> (1964), David Kohon's <u>Three</u> <u>Times Ana</u> (1964), and Manuel Antin's The Odd Number (1962).
