INDIAN LECTURES AT MUSEUM OF MODERN ART

Oliver La Farge will lecture on "Ever Changing Forms in Indian Art" Wednesday, February 12, at 9 P.M. in the auditorium of the Museum of Modern Art, 11 West 53 Street. The admission fee for the lecture is one dollar to the public and twenty-five cents to members of the Museum.

The Museum is open every Wednesday night until 10 P.M. It is suggested that those attending the lecture arrive an hour or so early so that they will have time to see the exhibition of Indian Art of the United States, current at the Museum, before going in to the lecture. Lecture tickets will admit to the galleries of the Museum without further charge.

On Thursday night, February 13, at nine o'clock, Rene d'Harnoncourt will lecture on "Indian Tribal Arts and Traditions" in the Museum auditorium, at an admission fee of one dollar to the public and twenty-five cents to members of the Museum. The Museum galleries will not be open Thursday night. Mr. d'Harnoncourt is General Manager of the Indian Arts and Crafts Board of the United States Department of the Interior. He directed the exhibition of Indian Art of the United States, which will be on view at the Museum until April 27.
