ROSAMUND GILDER TO DISCUSS THEATRE IN LECTURE SERIES ON FUTURE OF ARTS IN AMERICA AT MUSEUM OF MODERN ART

Miss Rosamund Gilder, Associate Editor of "Theatre Arts" and noted authority on the theatre, will give a lecture on The Theatre, tonight (Wednesday, March 19, at 8 P.M.) at the Museum of Modern Art, 11 West 53 Street. This lecture is the second in a series entitled The Future of the Arts in American Life and Culture arranged by the Museum in association with the Progressive Education Association, to discuss the place of the arts, theatre, music and literature in the world today.
