JUILLIARD PIANIST EMILY GEORGE PERFORMS IN STRAVINSKY SERIES AT THE MUSEUM OF MODERN ART

Friday and Saturday, August 17 and 18, 7:30 p.m. Sculpture Garden open from 6:00 to 10:00 p.m.

The seventh week of SUMMERGARDEN at The Museum of Modern Art features music for piano by Igor Stravinsky (1882-1971). SUMMERGARDEN, free weekend evenings in the Museum's Abby Aldrich Rockefeller Sculpture Garden, is made possible by PaineWebber Group, Inc. The 1990 concert series marks the fourth collaboration between the Museum and The Juilliard School. Emily George will be the featured artist in this weekend's program, which is as follows:

> Scherzo (1902) Sonata in F sharp minor (1904) Les Cinq doigts (1921) Sonata (1924) Serenade in A (1925) Tango (1940)

Four concerts in the SUMMERGARDEN series are being specially recorded at the Museum for PaineWebber's *Traditions*, a weekly radio program that is broadcast on Concert Music Network in over thirty major cities across the country. The third New York broadcast is scheduled for August 19 at 8:00 p.m. on WNCN-FM.

During SUMMERGARDEN, the Summer Café serves light fare and beverages. The Garden is open from 6:00 to 10:00 p.m., and concerts begin at 7:30 p.m.
