ANSEL ADAMS: 2 COURSES IN PHOTOGRAPHY

Six weeks, February 5 through March 17, 1945 at the Museum of Modern Art, 11 West 53 Street

ANSEL ADAMS is one of the greatest living photographers. A master technician and a brilliant teacher, he has written and illustrated several books, "Making a Photograph," "Sierra Nevada," "Born Free and Equal," and many articles in photographic publications. He has photographed a variety of subjects for national magazines and government agencies. His work has been widely exhibited and is represented in many museums and private collections. He was official photomuralist to the Department of the Interior.

THE FULL COURSE is designed for professional and advanced amateur photographers:

6 lectures, Mondays at 8:30 pm: Illustrated explanation of theory and practice

6 class discussions, Fridays at 8:30 pm: Open forum and print criticism

6 field trips, Saturdays: Indoor and outdoor demonstrations and class work in special techniques, lighting, portrait, landscape, etc.

6 private consultations, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, to be arranged with each subscriber: Individual analysis, with special assignments and darkroom work

This group will be limited to 25 people. The fee will be \$75. Applicants will be interviewed personally by Nancy Newhall, Acting Curator of Photography, during the week of January 22-26, from 1 to 5 pm daily, or by special arrangement. Appointments will be made by telephone. Registration will be closed and confirmed on January 29.
