his canvas was still empty.

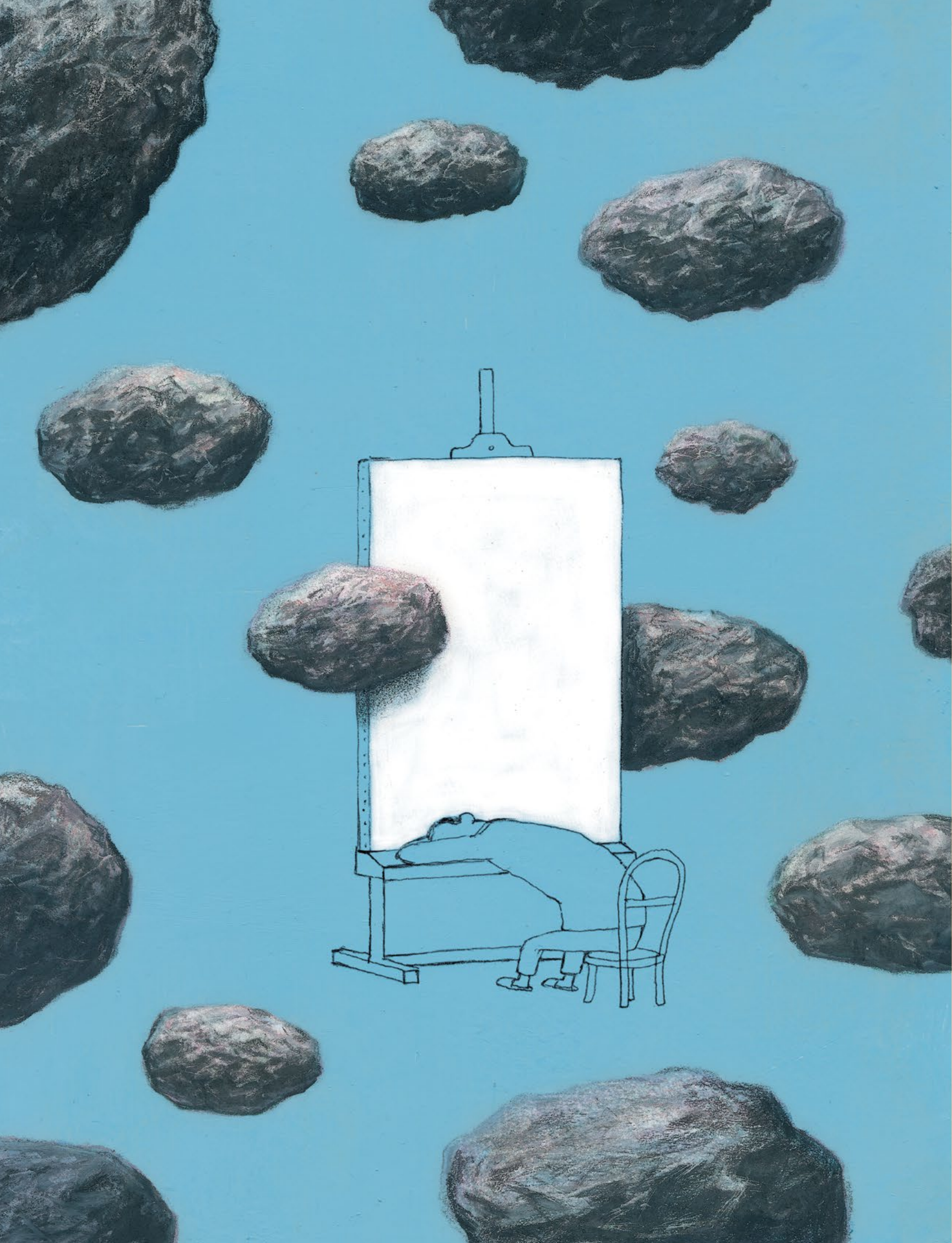


His canvas was empty,

Full of ideas about objects and words.

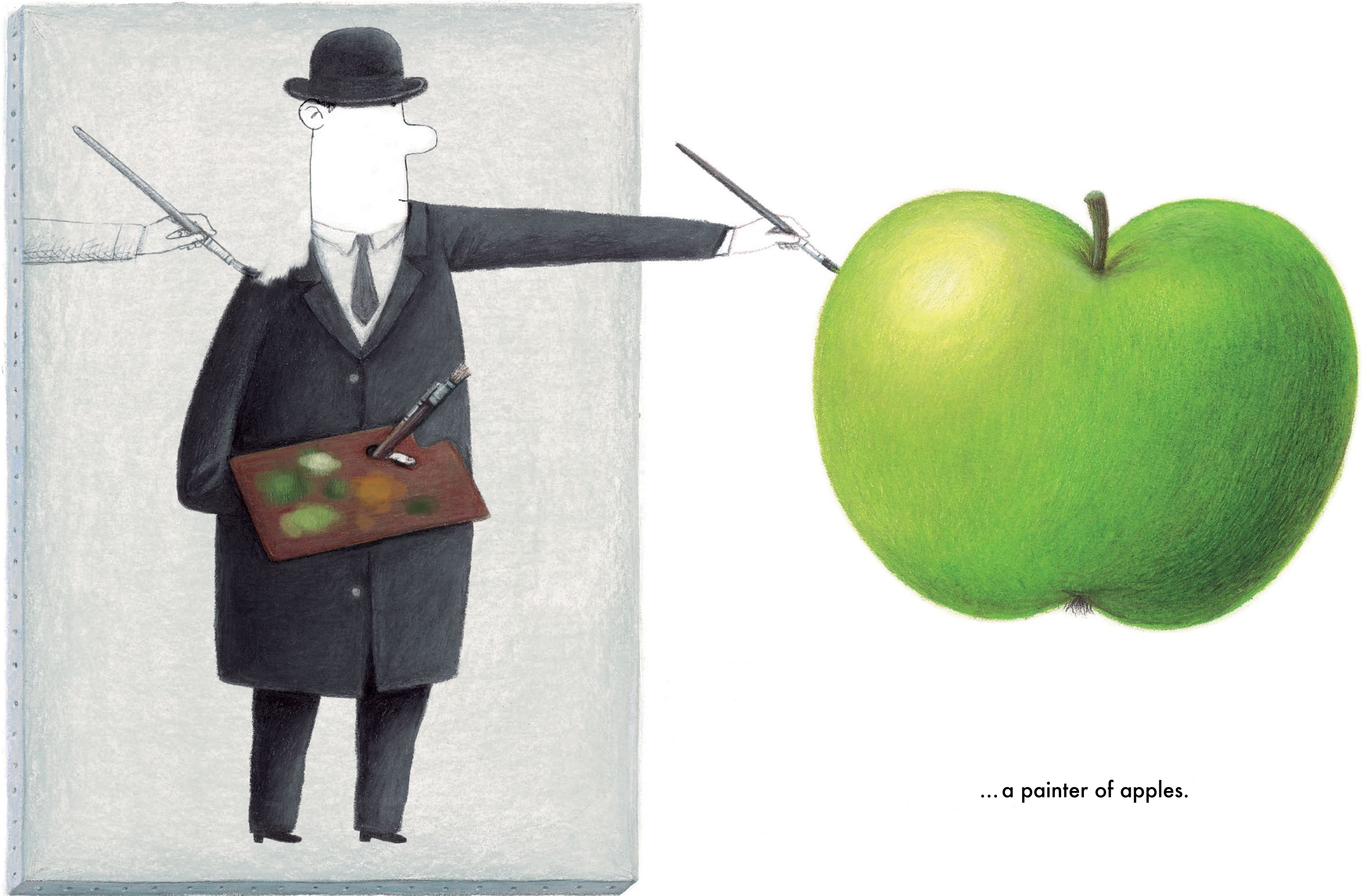
