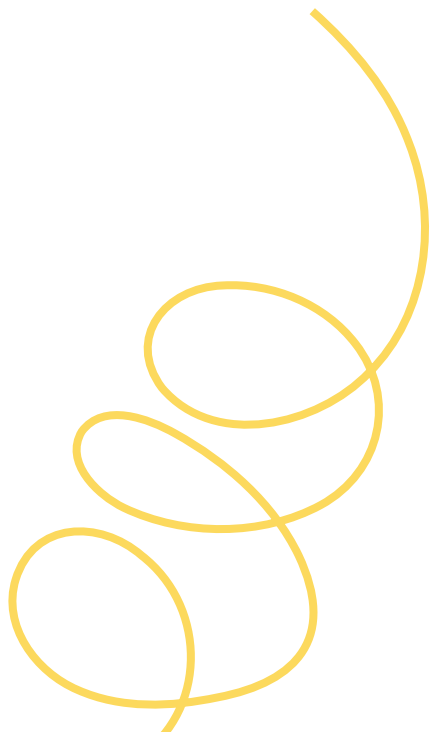

 **Click your tongue**




