On Saturday, January 15th from 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. a crane will be set up on 53rd Street near the Museum's main entrance causing the street to be closed to vehicular traffic. On Sunday, January 16th from 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. a crane will be set up on 54th Street in front of the Museum's loading dock requiring the closure of 54th Street.

One lane will be available for emergency vehicles. Also commercial vehicles serving businesses and residents will be allowed access. There will be no parking on 53rd and 54th Street during those hours.
