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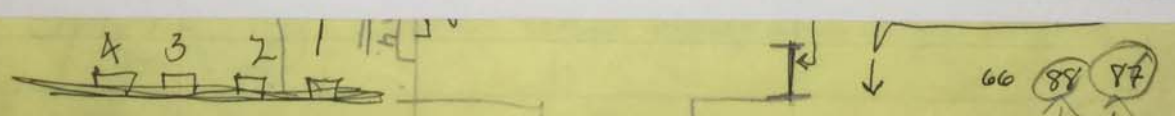

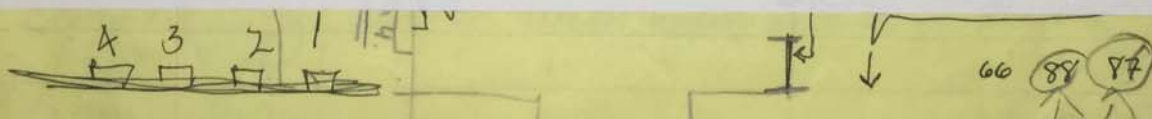
Dear Rebecca,

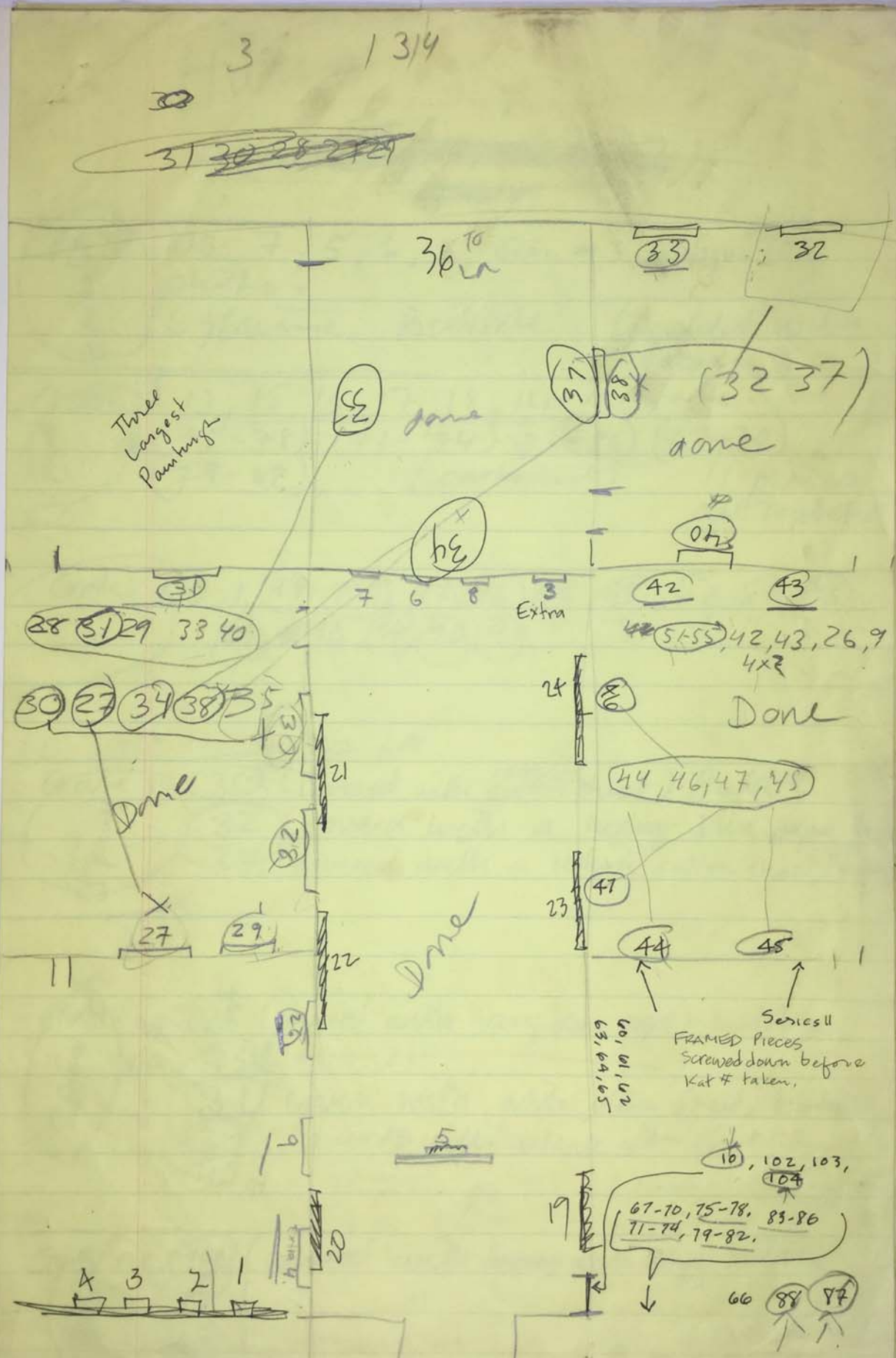
I am glad to hear the Ake Fant will have assistance and hope it all will run smoothly.
