For your guidance, we have today filed application for license, to effect this payment to you, and upon receipt of same from the U. S. Treasury Department, Washington, D. C., we shall be pleased to pay you the aforementioned amount, less our expenses incurred in this connection.

We are further advised that in accordance with recent regulations instituted by the French Foreign Exchange Office, Messrs. Morgan & Cie are only permitted to effect an initial payment of Fcs. 10,000., or its equivalent in dollars; thereafter, any additional funds required here by French nationals for living expenses are subject to the following requirement:

"Bills covering your expenses during the month preceding payment are to be lodged with us duly certified as to authenticity by the French Consulate."

In this connection, we are obliged to advise Messrs. Morgan & Cie, by cable, that we hold such bills and the total amount thereof before another payment will be authorized. Thereafter, we are required to forward these bills to them.

We respectfully request that you furnish us with these bills as soon as it is possible if you desire further payments.


