

Carpentry, plumbing, masonry and metal work:

On the first floor--

- New 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " full oak store door.
- Base moulding to be installed in store.
- Chair rail to be installed around entire store.
- Panel mouldings to be installed beneath chair rails.
- Ornamental brass railings to be installed at stairway at rear of store between two levels.
- Install imitation stringers for rear stair with moulding above to match base moulding.
- Remove fireplace and frame opening, plaster over, and continue base to match existing.
- Cut entire opening thru first and second floor beams for special enclosure to permit pictures to be raised or lowered. Finish beams in openings with ply-wood.
- Enclose entire opening in basement, first floor and second floor with 4" gypsum block partitions and plaster the partitions. Also install double doors of wood covered with metal on one side at each floor level.
- Install a set of rails and guides in shaft and construct a complete frame lift to be used for pictures.
- In two openings at rear of first floor install two sets of double doors of light construction. Also jambs.

On the second floor--

- Construct entire layout as per sketch with the three large doors.
- Install an oak panel wainscoting to height of window sill in front room and install a new oak base and moulding.
- Install new partitions with double sliding doors.
- Close fireplace, frame opening, plaster over and patch out the base.

On the third floor--

- Cut opening thru wall between bath and kitchen.
- Remove kitchen closet, cut back the tile.
- Install a new door complete with jamb, trim and hardware.
- Patch out tile where necessary due to this alteration.



Dear Mr. De Veyrac:

Enclosed are two details showing our recommendations for lighting of the two galleries by utilizing the existing equipment.

Drawing # 419-102A shows the existing equipment and the number of openings available which we plan to utilize inasmuch as they will afford uniform coverage of all display wall space in these two rooms.

There are eleven openings 22-7/8" long by 10-1/2" wide which will have two lens units each using 8-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fresnel lens. Two of similar size except that one corner is cut off as shown in the plan and six corner units of irregular shape which will require a single lens unit as shown. 150 Watt lamps should be used in these units which will be provided with adjustment to regulate the beam spread to suit individual conditions as well as to provide for spot lighting of a particular picture, if desired.

Each lens unit is furnished with an individual housing which is set into the existing metal apron and fastened to the two cross straps existing in each opening.

Drawing # 419-102 shows a section through the Fresnel lens unit to further illustrate its flexibility as to light distribution.



Heating

Item #1-1st floor store - Furnish and install the necessary labor and materials to complete the piping on cellar ceiling and make proper connections to the existing steam main and new radiator at new office space near front window. Piping in basement to be properly covered with air cell covering. New radiator to be equipped with new non packless radiator valve and air valve.

Item #2- Mr. Rosenberg's office - Furnish and install new type radiator to replace the existing old style, changing pipe connections to suit new radiator. Also furnish and install new radiator air and controll valve.

Item #3-2Nd floor hall radiator - Remove the existing small radiator and eplace same with new largest type to fit the present space changing pipe connections to suit and reusing the present radiator and air valves.

Item #4 - 3rd floor living room - Extend necessary pipe connections from present risers and install convection tupe radiators under two rear windows. Step to be provided over same with grilles by others.

General

The present water piping throughout the house, is, to the best of our knowledge, galvanized steel pipe and due to its age and the fact that it has been emptied for a period of time may not give the best of efficiency, but apparently the pipe sizes are of large enough capacity to overcome a good part of this deficiency. This could not be determined until water was turned on the piping and tested. Should any leaks occur upon turning on the water, repairs to same would be made at an additional charge.
