1. Pursuant to your application of September 16, 194 1 the following transaction is hereby licensed:

The Fifth Avenue Bank of New York is hereby authorized to debit your account the dollar equivalent E 14-3-0 and remit that amount to the Midland Bank, New Bond Street Branch, London, England, for the account of Rosenberg & Halft, Ltd.

This license is granted upon the statements and representations made in your application, or otherwise filed with or made to the Treasury Department as a supplement to your application, and is subject to the conditions, among others, that you will comply in all respects with Executive Order No. 8389 of April 10, 1940, as amended, the Regulations and Rulings issued thereunder and the terms of this license.

3. The licensee shall furnish and make available for inspection any relevant information, records or reports requested by the Secretary of the Treasury, the Federal Reserve Bank through which the license was issued, the Postmaster at the place of mailing or the Collector of Customs at the port of exportation.

4. This license expires 30 days from the date of its issuance, is not transferable, is subject to the provisions of Executive Order No. 8389 of April 10, 1940, as amended, and the Regulations and Rulings issued thereunder and may be revoked or modified at any time in the discretion of the Secretary of the Treasury acting directly or through the agency through which the license was issued, or any other agency designated by the Secretary of the Treasury. If this license was issued as a result of willful misrepresentation on the part of the applicant or his duly authorized agent, it may, in the discretion of the Secretary of the Treasury, be declared void from the date of its issuance, or from any other date.



Dear Mr. Rosenberg:

As requested in your letter of December 30th, we are arranging by cable for the payment of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.) to the Barclays Bank Limited, Chiswick, London, for credit in the account of Lucien Pissarro, stating that the funds are sent at your request and are for three pictures by Pissarro delivered to you. Your account has been charged \$10,003.60, the amount of the transfer, plus cable costs, and in accordance with your letter, we are noting that this is under Federal Reserve Bank of New York License No. NY57676.
