# Ian Hugo Collection Museum of Modern Art, Department of Film

*Ian Hugo* (February 15, 1898 – January 7, 1985), banker, artist and filmmaker, born Hugh Parker Guiler in Boston, Massachusetts. He took up engraving and etching in 1940 and filmmaking in 1950. Married to Anaïs Nin (1903-1977) in 1923, his engravings illustrated a number of her publications (e.g. *The Winter of Artifice*, 1945 edition).

His films include Ai-Ye, 1950; Bells of Atlantis, 1952; Jazz of Lights, 1954; Melodic Inversion, 1958; The Gondola Eye (1963-1971); Through the Magiscope, 1969; Apertura, 1970; Aphrodisiac I, 1971; Ian Hugo, Engraver and Filmmaker, 1972; Aphrodisiac II, 1972; Levitation, 1972; Transmigration, 1973; Transcending, 1974; Luminiscence, 1977 with Arnold Eagle; Reborn, 1979. A number of these films are in the Museum's collection.

#### Acquisition.

Received February, 2013. This selection of material from the Hugo Estate was the gift of Alexandra Soteriou of Hawthorne, New Jersey, heir to the collection maintained in her care since Hugo's death. Ms Soteriou began as the artist's "helper" in 1975 and, at the time of this gift, ran a "tree-free" paper production and products business, World Paper, Inc. from her home. The initial contact with Ms Soteriou was made in January 2012 by Judy Hecker, Assistant Curator in the Department of Prints and Illustrated Books. Associate Curator Ron Magliozzi made the selection of work on behalf of the Department of Film, sampling items from each category of material offered. These included copper plates, plaster cast, wood blocks, sketchbooks, and ephemera, but not tools. His choices were made on loose criteria of comparison between Hugo's engravings, prints and films (i.e. movement, subjects, and visual imagination).

#### Scope and content.

Engraving materials appear to date from the 1940's, including seven wood blocks, fifty-one copper plates, six sketchbooks and forty-four loose sketch sheets, and ten prints. Film exhibition-related documentation dates from the 1970's. The collection does NOT contain film production material.

The collection is housed in six archive boxes: five tan-colored, legal sized and one tan-colored, flat box.
